- 1. This show is subject to El Paso County Fair Association general rules and regulations.
- 2. Open to any contestant who is eligible to show in the El Paso County Fair.
- 3. Dairy Heifers must check-in and be weighed during posted check-in times on the EPCFA schedule.
- 4. Calves must be owned by June 15, of the current year. County 4-H Agents and Vocational Agriculture Teachers will certify that this rule is being followed with identification when they sign the entry form.
- 5. Certification of birth date by original breeder or breed certificate of registration will be required for entry.
- 6. All exhibitors of dairy heifers out of state must have certificates indicating that their heifers have had a negative TB test
- 7. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion will be selected from the first and second place entries in all classes
- 8. Dairy Heifers will be eligible for premium class monies and WILL NOT be eligible for Junior Market Auction.
- 9. CLASSES Class placements will be split according to birthdates
 - a. Class 1: Spring Heifer-Born March 1, 2023-May 31, 2023
 - **b.** Class 2: Winter Heifer- Born December 1. 2022-February 28, 2023
 - c. Class 3: Fall Heifer- Born September 1, 2022- November 30, 2022
 - d. Class 4: Summer Yearling Heifer- Born June 1, 2022- August 31, 2022
 - e. Class 5: Spring Yearling Heifer- Born March 1, 2022- May 31, 2022
 - f. **Class 6: Winter Yearling Heifer- Born December 1, 2021- February 28,2022***
 - g. **Class 7: Fall Yearling Heifer- Born September 1, 2021-November 30, 2021***
