

## JUNIOR MEAT GOAT SHOW

Entries must be submitted online by Saturday, September 16, 2017.

Late entries will be accepted with a \$25 penalty fee.

1. All meat goats will be wether male kids or nanny kids, one (1) year or younger, and have all their milk teeth.
2. No minimum or maximum weight.
3. All market lambs will be weighed, classified and tagged by the lamb committee. This weight will be official. There is no weigh back
4. All goats will be groomed with no more than ¼" of hair over the entire body. Longer hair below the knees and hocks is acceptable.
5. The number of classes will be determined based on the number of animals checked in
6. Dehorned is preferred, if horned, must be tipped to not less than the diameter of a dime at the end. No tipping will be allowed on the grounds.
7. Judging will not start until all goats that are to be judged are in the show ring or do not respond after the third call
8. Only each class winner will show for Grand Champion. Reserve Grand Champion will be selected from the remaining class winners, plus the 2nd place of the class producing the Grand Champion.
9. Exhibitors eligible for the sale must sell their highest placing animal.
10. Meat goats must be shown with a collar.
11. All exhibitors are responsible for daily care (feed and water) until the end of the show. Anyone caught leaving the animal uncared for will have a \$100.00 a day charge from the El Paso County Fair.
