Rules and Regulations

1. Entry fee of \$25.00 due with application.
2. All contestants must be single:
Queen contestants must be enrolled in grades 11-12.
Princess contestants must be enrolled in grades 9-10.
3. Contestants must reside and attend school in El Paso County.
4. Contestants must be an exhibitor in the El Paso County Fair.
5. Decisions of the judges will be final.
6. The Queen/Princess will be required to be present at all Fair activities for pictures, assisting in the presentation of awards and for the appropriate duties for a full year.
7. The Queen/Princess will represent the El Paso County Fair Association in parades, community events (television, radio, and newspaper) and any event where the Fair is asked to participate.
8. Current Queen/ Princess Winners are unable to compete during the next years' competition of the same category.
9. Additional fundraising will be required.
