

JUNIOR BEEF BREEDING HEIFERS

Entries must be submitted online by September 16, 2026

ALL BEEF HEIFERS MUST HAVE A CERTIFICATE OF VETERINARY INSPECTION

1. This show is subject to El Paso County Fair Association general rules and regulations.
2. Open to any contestant who is eligible to show in the El Paso County Fair.
3. Breeding Heifers are not required to be registered but must be purebred and must show the characteristics of the beef breed.
4. Breeding Heifers must be trained to lead with a halter. Heifers unable to be controlled may be eliminated from the competition. This will be determined by the Superintendent.
5. Six breeding Heifers will constitute a lot, if there are more than six Heifers in a class the class will be broken down by age. If there are more than three of any breed, then a separate breed class will be made for the breed. (Superintendent will determine classes)
6. Beef Heifers will be eligible for premium class monies and WILL NOT be eligible for Junior Market Premium Sale.
7. Grand Champion Breeding Heifer will be selected from the 1st place heifers from class. Reserve Grand Champion Breeding Heifer will be selected from the 1st place heifers from class and the 2nd place heifer from class that produced the Grand Champion.
