

JUNIOR BEEF STEERS

Entries must be submitted online by September 16, 2026

ALL STEERS MUST HAVE A CERTIFICATE OF VETERINARY INSPECTION

1. This show is subject to El Paso County Fair Association general rules and regulations.
2. Open to any contestant who is eligible to show in the El Paso County Fair.
3. Steer may be purebred, grade, or crossbred of any recognizable breed. Heifers will not be permitted to show in this class. Steers will not be shown by breed but will be classified by weight.
4. Steers must check-in during posted check-in times on the EPCFA schedule.
5. Each steer must be trained to lead with a halter. Calves unable to be controlled may be eliminated from the competition. This will be determined by the Superintendent.
6. The number of animals in each class and the number of classes will be determined by the Superintendent and the Executive Board based on the number of animals checked in.
7. Steers will be checked for age by the Superintendent or her assistant. Any steer with two large permanent teeth showing signs of wear will be sifted regardless of other qualifications.
8. Steers can be shown slick or blocked. Altering the physical appearance of the animal is strictly prohibited.
9. Grand Champion will be chosen from 1st place animals in each weight class. Reserve Grand Champion will be selected from the remaining 1st place animals and the 2nd place animal from the class that produced the Grand Champion
10. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Steers must participate in the Junior Livestock Premium Sale. Other sale slots will be determined by Show Officials
