

JUNIOR MARKET GOAT SHOW

ALL GOATS MUST HAVE A CERTIFICATE OF VETERINARY INSPECTION

1. This show is subject to El Paso County Fair Association general rules and regulations.
2. Open to any contestant who is eligible to show in the El Paso County Fair.
3. Goats must check in and be weighed during posted check-in times on the Fair schedule. 4. Exhibitors are allowed to use halters or collars.
5. Exhibitors will get 3 calls for class before not being allowed to show.
6. Exhibitors will not show in any class other than their designated class. If an exhibitor shows in any other class than their designated class they will be disqualified.
7. All meat goats will be wethered kids or nanny kids, 1 year or younger, and have all their milk teeth.
8. Dehorned is preferred. Horns must not exceed 2 inches in length and must be tipped blunt to a minimum of 1 inch diameter before arrival on the grounds.
9. Goats must be shorn with no more than ¼" of hair over the entire body. Longer hair below the knees and hocks is acceptable.
10. Goats found to have any physical abnormalities, parasites, or open wounds will be barred from showing at the discretion of Show Management.
11. Classes will be determined following completion of check-in. There will be no pre-set weight breaks. There is no top weight.
12. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion must participate in the Junior Livestock Premium Sale. Remaining sale slots will be determined by Show Officials
