ALL LAMBS MUST HAVE A CERTIFICATE OF VETERINARY INSPECTION

1. This show is subject to El Paso County Fair Association general rules and regulations.
2. Open to any contestant who is eligible to show in the El Paso County Fair.
3. Lambs must check-in and be weighed during posted check-in times on the EPCFA schedule.
4. Wethers and ewes are eligible to show.
5. Lambs are to be slick shorn prior to check-in and are to be shown with no more than ¼" of uniform fleece over the body. No blocking, flat backs, etc. will be permitted. Longer fleece is permissible on the head and below the hocks and knees. Altering the physical appearance of the animal is strictly prohibited.
6. Lambs found to have any physical abnormalities, parasites, or open wounds will be barred from showing at the discretion of Show Management.
7. Classes will be determined following completion of check-in. There will be no pre-set weight breaks. There is no top weight.
8. If necessary lambs may be moved into another breed in the following manner: Fine wool to Fine wool cross – Fine wool cross to medium wool – Southdown to medium wool – Dorper/Hair sheep to medium wool. 5 or more of any one breed will constitute a class.
9. Show order:
Fine wool
Fine wool crossbred
Southdown
Medium wool
10. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion must participate in the Junior Livestock Premium Sale. Remaining sale slots will be determined by Show Officials.
