

JUNIOR POULTRY

Entries must be submitted by September 16, 2026

ALL POULTRY MUST HAVE A CERTIFICATE OF VETERINARY INSPECTION

1. This show is subject to El Paso County Fair Association general rules and regulations.
2. Open to any contestant who is eligible to show in the El Paso County Fair.
3. ALL POULTRY must meet the current testing and health requirements as outlined by the Texas Animal Health Commission.
4. Entry will consist of single or pen of three (3). Each exhibitor will be limited to three (3) entries per class.
5. All exhibits must have been owned by exhibitor by June 25, 2026, except broilers which must have been raised by the exhibitor or owned for at least 45 days.
6. Exhibitors must care for the exhibits and furnish substantial feed and water containers. They must be removed at the completion of the show.
7. Exhibitors must be present at time of judging. Judge(s) will explain reasons for poultry placement.
8. A single or pen of three market poultry-no sex discrimination of pen of three (3) (breeding). A pen of three (3) may not be separated or divided.
9. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion must participate in the Junior Livestock Premium Sale. Additional sale slots will be determined by the Fair Board
10. The superintendent of the Poultry Division and/or judge may declare and establish new classes in the Poultry Division where:
 - There are more than two (2) birds in the breed or hybrid class
 - Quality merits a special class
 - Any other reason deemed appropriate.
11. Champion will be given only in those classes that quality warrants this will be at the discretion of the Judge.

Clarification

- Hen or Cock-Bird over (1) year of age
- Cockerel or Pullet-Bird under (1) year of age
- Old Trio-One(1), two (2) Hens over one (1) year
- Young Trio-One (1) Cockerel and two Pullets under one (1) year
- Market Poultry-Single or Pen of three (3)-no sex discrimination
- Breeding Poultry-Pen of three (3)-one(1) male and two (2) females
- Pen of three (3) cannot be divided or separated.
